A RESOLUTION COMMENDING LOCO'YAKS FOR CONDUCTING THE FIRST ANNUAL BLACK RIVER CLEAN-UP 2013.

WHEREAS, the LoCo'Yaks, a group of local kayaking and paddling enthusiasts, conducted a clean-up of the Black River and Lakefront area on Sunday, May 5, 2013 to enhance the environmental condition of the waterfront and the area; and

WHEREAS, due to the coordination of these enthusiasts, over 200 people from all walks of life and age groups participated in the clean-up effort; and

WHEREAS, through their efforts, approximately _____ tons of litter and debris were collected along with tires, thereby helping restore the conditions of the River and Lakefront areas.
